The Boomer Fund is a charity account and ministry of the Calhoun Seventh-day Adventist Church, funded principally by members of the Boomer Sabbath School Class, and is overseen and executed by the "Boomer Fund Finance Committee." The Fund's primary focus is in cooperating with parent(s) and students primarily of Coble Elementary School and Georgia Cumberland Academy, who are financially struggling to continue their education at these Seventh-day Adventist educational institutions.

The Boomer Fund Finance Committee has committed to prioritizing (but not limited to) funding to faithful, active members of the Calhoun Seventh-day Adventist Church who are financially challenged, to provide Adventist education for their children. Funding will also be prioritized to widows, grandparent guardians and single parent families. Race, color, ethnic background, nor education status will be considered criteria for assistance.

Application for assistance will be considered three (3) times yearly:

- 1) July 1st until one (1) week prior to registration
- 2) November 1st to December 15th
- 3) April 1st until one (1) week prior to final exams

Applications filed and received outside these time periods will be markedly compromised secondary to funding already being allocated to timely applications.

Applications will be considered when you have exhausted all other resources, i.e. family members, financial aid from the school, a close examination of home finances focusing on non-essentials. In order to be good stewards of this money we will need to prioritize those with the greater needs based upon the applications we receive.
